Job duties:

- Develop practice schedules using knowledge of high-level gymnastics skills and progressions.
- Monitor gymnastics activities of all participants, intervening to correct technique where necessary.
- Coach and instruct students, individually or in groups, regarding the rules, regulations, and proper use of equipment
- Observe and spot athletes as they perform on various apparatus during practice and competition to help determine the needs for individual or team improvement.
- Create and maintain positive relationships with participants, aiming to encourage them in a positive attitude.
- Teach skills at each apparatus, following proper progressions set in place using knowledge of level 10/international level skills.
- Prepare lesson plans for Competitive Team Groups in conjunction with Head Coach using Federation of International Gymnastics standards
- Complete student attendance, assessments, and timesheets on time.
- Establish and maintain professionalism while supervising students and coaches during practice and meets.
- Meet with parents as necessary regarding the performance and behavior of students, encouraging and promoting member and parent involvement.
- Act as a team representative and promote gymnastics by communicating with parents, visitors, etc.
- Assist with maintaining equipment, supplies, and uniforms.
- Develop and sustain positive relationships with participants and coaches, and provide motivational support and guidance.
- Follow all AFGA emergency and safety procedures. Complete incident and accident reports as necessary.
- Maintain Gymnastics area to with Safety and Cleanliness in mind
- Uphold all AFGA policies, procedures, standards and code of conduct.
- Fulfill other functions designated by the Gymnastics Coordinator for the betterment of the program and the ability of AFGA to meet its mission.
